Profile

Futa represents the most elegant expression of Calcu. The grapes were harvested from the finest vineyards owned by the Hurtado Family on their Marchigüe estate and the wine-making process preserved the full glory and majesty of the terroir. The 2009 harvest was a special one: temperatures were warmer than any other harvest over the previous 10 years. This meant that the grapes could be picked very early allowing for a fine natural balance of alcohol, acidity and freshness.

Terroir

The grapes come from a vineyard in Marchigüe, located 25 km away from the Pacific Ocean in the West side of the Colchagua valley. The vineyards settled in the rolling hills of Marchigüe are special for the granitic soils, with a high concentration of clay, and for the excellent drainage, characteristic of the smooth slopes of the landscape. The Cabernet Sauvignon from these vineyards have a fantastic power, structure and elegance.
