

## Chan de Rosas Clásico Albariño 2021

### Profile

The 2021 vintage is very typical of the Albariño grape itself and the Rias Baixas Region. Pale yellow with greenish highlights it looks like a little sunshine in your glass. In the nose we have excellent aromas of white fruits: pear-apple, some orange blossoms. A very tasty and refreshing dry wine with perfect acidity. A great balance and evolution in the bottle at the same time delicate and expressive. All this finished with a touch of smooth mineral/honey aftertaste for a perfect balance.

### Terroir

Vineyards located in the heart of Salnés Valley, birthplace of albariño in Galicia. On the shores of Arousa river, this region benefits from an Atlantic climate and has a unique soil resulting from limestone decomposition. The harvest is carried out by hand in 15 kilos boxes.

### Harvest & Winemaking

**Harvest:** 100% hand harvested

**Winemaking:** Fermentation and ageing in stainless steel vats

**Ageing:** Minimum 3 month of lees stirring every week
