

## **Tiraki Pinot Noir 2021**

100% Pinot Noir

Marlborough, New Zealand Alcohol: 13.5%

#### **Profile**

A complex and concentrated Pinot Noir with aromas of cherry, dark spice and violets. On the palate black cherry and doris plum mingle with subtle spicy oak and silky tannins giving the wine structure while maintaining elegance.

#### **Terroir**

Clay based soils. Beautiful conditions, with a long dry season, slightly cooler towards the end which locked in flavours. Longfield Farm was established in 1870. With six generations involved over the past 150 years, the 260Ha property has evolved substantially. However, what has remained constant is the family's commitment to providing products of the highest quality whilst continuing to nurture the land for future generations.

## **Harvest & Winemaking**

The fruit was hand picked with the majority being destemmed and fermented in four ton open top fermenters. 10% whole bunches were included to add freshness and vibrancy to the wine. Aged in French oak for 11 months 20% of which was new
