Profile

Grand Reserve is the result of a very own interpretation of some of the most traditional Old World varieties. Most of all, it shows their commitment to make an impression with flavors and aromas, the strength of the fruit, a full and gentle mouthfeel, and smooth but full of character wines. This wine is a blend of Tempranillo, a variety of Rioja, origin that provides its intense red color, bluish at first, and darker and deeper when maturing; always fruity, the ripe cherry notes stand out; and Cabernet Sauvignon, to which the notes of red fruits and light cassis are owed.

Terroir

The vineyard is located 36 km south-east of Talca city and 18 km south-east of San Javier city (San Javier Area.)

Harvest & Winemaking

Harvest: 100% hand harvested

Harvest date: Handpicked mid March

Alcoholic fermentation: Inoculation with select yeasts.

Aging: 60% of the wine in a blend oak for 8 months
(about 40% French oak -60% American oak)
